## 2017 Summer Horseshoe Rules

Players: Each Team will consist of 2 Players.

Times: Matches will start at 7:00 each night. If you cannot make your scheduled match time, you are responsible for calling and letting us know your team will not be making it. (A 2 hour notice is appreciated.)

### Rules:

- Teams must be on time to play. If the team is more than 15 minutes late they will forfeit and opposing teams will win that match.
- Teams are responsible for finding/contacting their own subs.
- Each team will play 3 matches (Different Teams) a night subject to byes.
- Players may stand on either side of the pit as long as they don't step passed the pad area when throwing. Women may choose to throw from either men's pad or women's pad.
- Each Game won will be worth 1 point in the standings.
- House shoes will be used for all matches.
- Measuring for points will be as follows: 3 points for a ringer. (Measured by, if both end points on the shoe are able to touch the shoe that is used to measure it, at the same time.) 1 point will be given for any shoe that is within a shoe width away from the stake. 1 point will be given for any shoe that is leaning against the stake.
